This has been a very exciting week in our K2 classroom. Our scholars are settling into routines and are doing a great job of making social connections! We have been working on our fall poetry unit this week. In poetry we do class exercises such as chorally reading the poem, identifying high frequency words, filling in the blank with vocabulary words and re-constructing the poem ourselves using sentence strips.

In math we are just finishing up our unit on sorting. It has been wonderful to see scholars applying this knowledge outside the walls of our math class. Scholars are able to classify and sort objects in the hallway and out at the park as well! In writing, we are working on telling stories through the use of illustrations. Scholars have started to orally share their stories with their classmates. It is truly amazing to see their imaginations at work!

In religion we are working on a unit about the gift of light. Scholars have discussed with each other activities that can be done during the day and other activities that can be done at night. We have shared vocabulary such as morning, afternoon, night etc.
